## Counter-Mapping with Water Stories, the Great Western Woodlands, Elders and Young People

Using Mike Duggan and Daniel Gutiérrez-Ujaque's (2025) provocation of counter-mapping as praxis, Cat and Mindy use this framing as a place to begin their understandings of the emergent and relational mapping practices they have been developing with place, Elders, young people, and each other. These maps do so much more than just document contemporary water stories. They are creative, participatory, and pedagogical. Come and hear how Cat and Mindy are thinking with ethnographic methods that challenge colonial cartographic practices.
