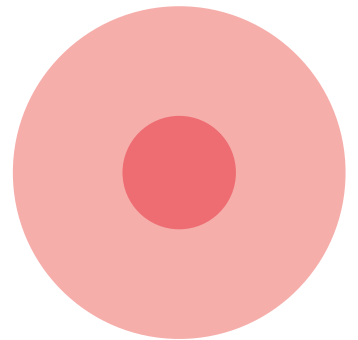
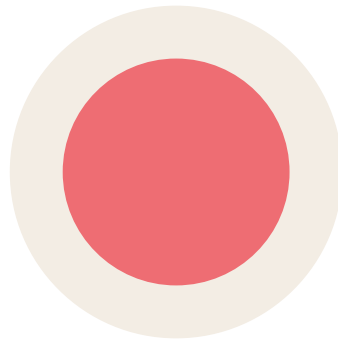
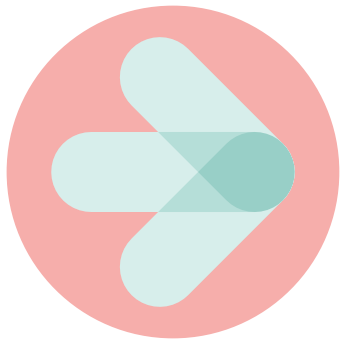
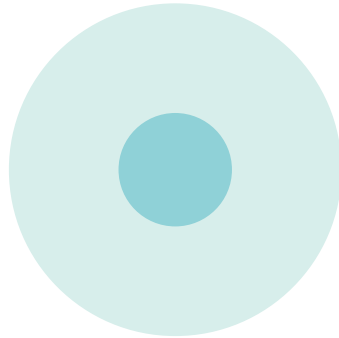
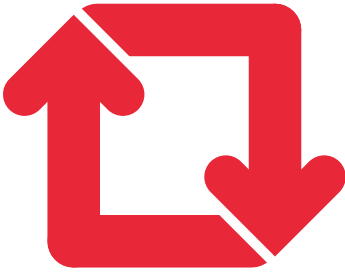
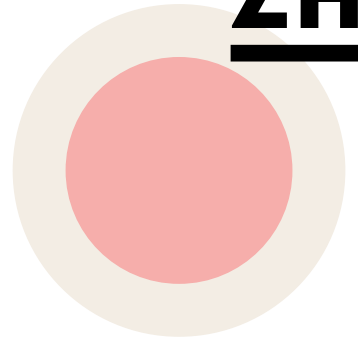
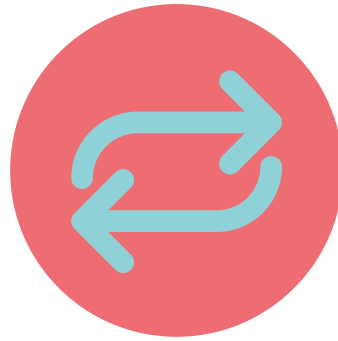
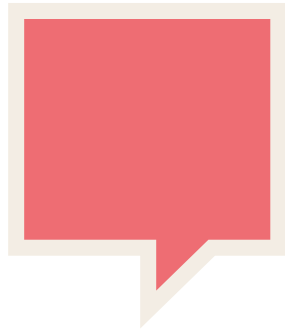
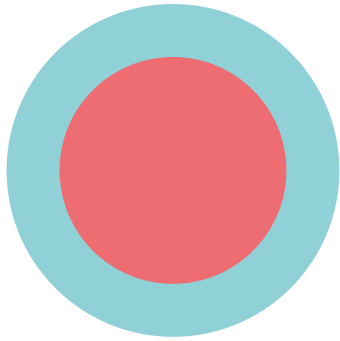




International Projects in Education

Teaching and Learning

The Department for International Projects in Education (IPE) is committed to teaching that not only promotes the acquisition of knowledge and skills, but also encourages personal initiative. Those who already learn at school how to acquire knowledge in an active, constructive and self-directed manner will benefit from this in their adult lives.

In the projects of the Department IPE, competence-oriented teaching and learning is given high priority. Students and teachers are trained accordingly. In this context, teaching and learning means acquiring and passing on knowledge and skills while incorporating one's own values and experiences.

Professional development and materials

The Department IPE offers continuing professional development on the topic of competence-oriented teaching in many countries. Depending on a partner's needs, the training courses are aimed at teachers, headmasters, lecturers, parents, or NGO staff. The teaching materials required for a project are developed together with the local education experts. These can be hard copy or digital materials, from handouts to full manuals, aimed at lecturers and/or students from teacher training colleges, at teachers or directly at pupils. The Department IPE has many years of experience in developing teaching materials that are adapted to the curriculum of a partner country.

The project "Better Teaching for a Better Future" aims to promote the pedagogical-didactical competences of lecturers at teacher training colleges in Armenia, Georgia and the Republic of Moldova.
